

Bona Hard Floor Refresher

Bona Hard Floor Refresher is a ready-to-use waterborne maintenance polish for a large variety of hard surface floors including laminate flooring, vinyl, linoleum, terrazzo, unglazed tile (ceramic, quarry), stone and sealed marble. Bona Hard Floor Refresher is easy to apply and brings back long lasting shine to dull surfaces.

- Versatile, works with many different surfaces.
- Suitable for both residential and commercial locations.
- Polyurethane reinforced = superb protective qualities.
- Quick drying formula.

Dilution:	Do not dilute - the product is ready-to-use
Drying time:	Surface dry: 30-60 minutes hour (20°C/ 60% RH) Recoatible: approx. 2 hours (20°C/ 60% RH)
Application tools:	Bona MicroFibre Applicator Pad
Coverage:	Approx. 50 m ² /litre
Safety:	Unclassified; Keep out of reach of children. If swallowed drink 1 or 2 glasses of water to dilute
Shelf life:	2 years from the date of production, in unopened original container.
Storage/Transport:	The temperature must not fall below +5°C or exceed +25°C during storage and transport.
Disposal:	Wastes and emptied containers should be handled in accordance with local regulations.
Pack size:	12 x 1 litre (32 boxes a pallet)

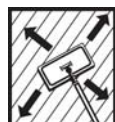
Preparations

Remove loose dirt and grit from your floor. Clean floor thoroughly with Bona Hard Floor Cleaner. Repeat to ensure that dirt will not be trapped in the coating. Make sure the floor is completely dry before applying Bona Hard Floor Refresher. Do not use over any floor that has been waxed or oiled. Wax and oil residues will prevent the proper adhesion of Bona Hard Floor Refresher to the floor. **Always test floors for appearance and adhesion in an inconspicuous area before use.**

Application



1. Rock container back & forth several times before opening. Apply Bona Hard Floor Refresher with the Bona Microfiber applicator pad. Prepare the applicator pad by slightly dampening it with water. Apply in a 3-4 cm wide wavy line on the floor. Work on a small section at a time, about 3 m².



2. Spread the product over entire small section making sure all wood is covered. The application should be done at approx. 50 m² per litre. For best results, apply a thin consistent coat. Depending on floor texture and porosity be sure to keep the applicator wet with

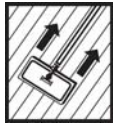

Refresher. If Refresher is spread too thin, streaking may occur. Keep airborne dust and airflow to a minimum while floor is wet.



3. Smooth out, going with the grain of the wood. Continue the process until the entire floor is coated. Allow to dry a minimum of 1 hour before walking on coated floors. If needed, a second coat may be applied after 2 hours. Always coat the entire floor to ensure an even appearance and sheen.

Note: Avoid heavy traffic and replacement of furniture and rugs for 24 hours after the final coat. Clean tools with soap and water.

Maintenance

Damp-cleaning of the floor may be resumed after one week. To keep the floor in good health use the Bona Hard Floor Cleaning System regularly. Do not use strongly alkaline cleaning agents as they may damage the floor. For floors in homes, one or two applications of Refresher a year is usually enough to protect the floor. Inspect the floor occasionally to ensure that the maintenance schedule is reflecting the level of wear.
